Thanks for including the photos. This office coordinated with Police and VDOT yesterday to facilitate safe travel around this intersection, and other co-workers and I have personally noticed the flooding during previous storms before emergency personnel arrived.

As you know, Supervisor Gross is fully supportive of the effort to resolve this flooding issue at a heavily used intersection and adjacent to a Fire Station.
