Hi Penny:

I was out all yesterday and this AM so am only now able to send you the results of the 7 Corners Meeting we had with the Falls Church Planning Commission meeting/work Session and including their Citizen Transportation Advisory Committee Monday evening.

In summary, think that it went well.

I lead off with the process of how we got to where we are now.
Then Bernie Suchicital from Comp. Planning laid out the draft plan
Finally Mike Garcia described the Transportation Plan

Most of the questions were as you might expect on transportation with one of the PC members annoyed that we had not reached out more to them especially with some of the "fixes" (Hillwood Ave / South St.) that will have to take place in Falls Church. We pointed out that these were preliminary, and had been discussed with FC staff etc and that quieted that member. One other issue they pointed out was that one of the other connections (loop off of Roosevelt through FC to Broad St) was at a point where the grade differences were so severe that a connection is highly problematic.

The Citizen Transportation Committee was supportive and most of the PC members were also.

We also pointed out that the real land use density we were proposing was in the "opportunity Areas" which are not near to Falls Church.

After the meeting we continued a dialogue with individual members and it was all positive and supportive of what they saw.
