I read John Thillmann's remarks from last night's meeting and, while he discussed consensus, or lack of it, the overall impression was that the task force was finishing the recommendations for two areas with general consensus by the task force. I've only seen the Annandale Blog report, which has been commenting on the discussions, although not always accurately. Until Mr. Knapp's outrageous and ill-conceived proposal for the Sears site, there was little vocal opposition in the community to the rest of the task force's work, but certainly there are still questions to be addressed before the language goes to the Planning Commission.

I appreciate your New Year's wishes, and I will pass them along to my husband, who is Jewish, and married a shiksa. I've learned a lot about Jewish religious and cultural observances from Hal, but I was raised Catholic.
