>> In my 20 Aug e-mail below, I asked to know the employer/industry of every task force member. I did not receive the information I requested.

>> For the 14 current TF members, you provided employer/industry information for 6 (5 property representatives and the Exec Dir of the Seven Corners Children's Center). The remaining 8 TF members are described as 7 "residents" plus 1 "community member." The description of the residents and community member is insufficient. The community has a right to know the employer/industry of all task force members, not just 6 of the 14.

>> If it is necessary to ask the 7 residents and 1 community member for their employer/industry information, please ask them and then send me the information prior to the Sep 9 task force meeting. I would appreciate receiving the information in the form of a revised version of the table you sent yesterday.

>> Mr. Frank, I believe that there is no need to argue the need for this information to be easily accessible in the public domain. The need is obvious if there is any expectation that the task force report will be credible. As the information you provided now stands, the task force could consist of 5 representatives of 7C property owners, a director of a children's center in one of the properties, and 8 representatives of construction companies. If that were the case, we would need to start over.
